PART 1 GENERAL

1.1 SECTION INCLUDES

- A. Music shells.

1.2 SUBMITTALS

- A. Comply with Section 01 33 00 – Submittal Procedures.
- B. Product Data: Submit manufacturer's product data.

- C. Shop Drawings: Submit manufacturer's shop drawings, including plans, elevations, sections, and details, indicating dimensions, tolerances, materials, components, fabrication, fasteners, hardware, finish, options, and accessories.
- D. Manufacturer's Certification: Submit manufacturer's certification that materials comply with specified requirements and are suitable for intended application.
- E. Manufacturer's Project References: Submit manufacturer's list of successfully completed music shell projects, including project name and location, name of architect, and type and quantity of music shells furnished.
- F. Operation and Maintenance Data: Submit manufacturer's operation and maintenance manuals, including operation, maintenance, and cleaning instructions.
- G. Warranty Documentation: Submit manufacturer's standard warranty.

1.3 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Manufacturer's Qualifications: Minimum 10 years of experience in the manufacturing of music shells of similar type to that specified.

1.4 DELIVERY AND STORAGE

- A. Delivery Requirements: Deliver music shells to site in manufacturer's original, unopened containers and packaging, with labels clearly identifying product name and manufacturer.
- B. Storage Requirements: Store music shells at location designated by the Owner.

1.5 WARRANTY

- A. Warranty Period: 5 years from date of delivery.

2.2 MUSIC SHELLS

- A. Music Shells: "Alla Breve".
- B. Description:
 - 1. Self-standing, portable music shells.
 - 2. Reflect a maximum range of audible frequencies.

- C. Size:
 - 1. Range of Setup Heights: 8'-8-1/2" to 13'-4".
 - 2. Storage Height: 79-1/2 inches.
 - 3. Width: 6'-3/8".
 - 4. Fits through standard doorways in storage position.
- D. Weight: 210 pounds.
- E. Setup:
 - 1. Positioned and setup by 1 person with no tools or loose parts (a second person to spot ceiling obstructions is recommended).
 - 2. Base: Fitted with locking swivel casters.
 - 3. Raising to Performance Position or Lowering to Storage Position: Maximum of 15 pounds of lift effort.
- F. Storage: Shells nest compactly in storage.
- G. Panel Construction:
 - 1. Panels: Sandwich laminate, 7/8 inch thick.
 - 2. Core: Honeycomb, 3/4 inch thick.
 - 3. Surfaces:
 - a. 0.060-inch ABS plastic.
 - b. Color: Warm Beige.
 - 4. Side Channel: Aluminum.
- H. Frame Construction:
 - 1. Base Tube: 2-inch-OD EWFC steel.
 - 2. Inner Tube: 1-3/4-inch-diameter EWFC steel.
 - 3. Outer Tube: 2-inch-OD EWFC steel.
 - 4. Weight Assists:
 - a. 2 per unit.
 - b. 30-pound cast gray iron.
 - 5. Pulley Cable: 3/32-inch-diameter galvanized wire rope.
 - 6. Casters:
 - a. Size: 3-inch diameter by 1-1/4-inch wide.
 - b. Rated: 200 pounds each.
 - c. Swivel with lock.
